

Dear all,

Thank you for your registration for the *notebynote* 'Rossini from scratch' on Saturday 17th March.

Singer's registration: please arrive by 10am, we will start singing at 10.30am.

If it's possible to make the payment of 25CHF in advance please do so as this will considerably ease the registration time on the day. If not then please remember to bring 25CHF for registration. The registration fee covers the cost of the venue & materials required for the event.

Singers: The afternoon rehearsal with the chorus singers will be finished by 5pm, please plan to return to the church by no later than 6.30 pm.

Orchestra: If possible please arrive before 10.30 am to set up in time for a 10.30am start. We will have a short rehearsal with the soloists and orchestra at 5pm. Music stands will be provided.

Concert: the evening performance will begin at 7 pm. Please do invite all of your family, friends & colleagues along to support us. There is no entrance fee for the evening concert but there will be a retiring collection.

Hot drinks & refreshments will be provided throughout the day but please make your own arrangements for meals. The lunch break will be approximately 12.30 – 1.30pm.

Donations of home baked goods towards the provided refreshment table are not obligatory, however they are always appreciated 😊

Scores: We will be using the Peters edition however if you have a score please bring it with you, whichever edition you have. Some scores are available for purchase at 25 CHF each, first come, first served. It is possible to reserve a score in advance to either pick up on the day or to collect in advance from Divonne.

Concert dress: the evening performance will be an informal concert so we are asking for casual-smart black & white for singers/ all black for orchestra – with a touch of red (tie, scarf.....)

It's not too late to invite more singers to come along & join in!

Please do also forward the poster and share the event on Facebook with all of your family, friends & colleagues. Anyone is invited to come & sing but we are also looking for an audience for the concert so please invite people to this also.

Travelling by car:

Do try to come by public transport or sharing cars if possible as it is quite expensive to leave a car in Geneva for the whole day. The nearest car parks are:

Cornavin parking, Rue du Mont-Blanc 30, 1201 Genève

Parking des Alpes, Rue Sigismond-Thalberg 12

Grenus (Manor) Parking, Place De-Grenus 9: However be aware that this parking closes at 8.30pm

Parking is also available at the airport and it is a short train ride to Cornavin station.

Travelling by public transport:

Many trains, trams and buses stop at Gare Cornavin: trams 14, 15, 18, buses 1, 3, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 19, 25, 27, 61, F, V, Z.

Other bus stops include Goulart (Rue Terreaux-du-Temple) tram 15, bus 1. Rue Chantepoulet buses 6, 8, 9, 25, G. Coutance (Rue de Cornaviin) tram 14, 18, buses 3, 5, 10, 19.

To find the Temple:

Walking from standing in front of Cornavin station: turn right along Rue de Lausanne, cross over the road to Rue Terreaux-du-Temple. Walk past the Place Simon-Goulart and the Temple is on the left.
