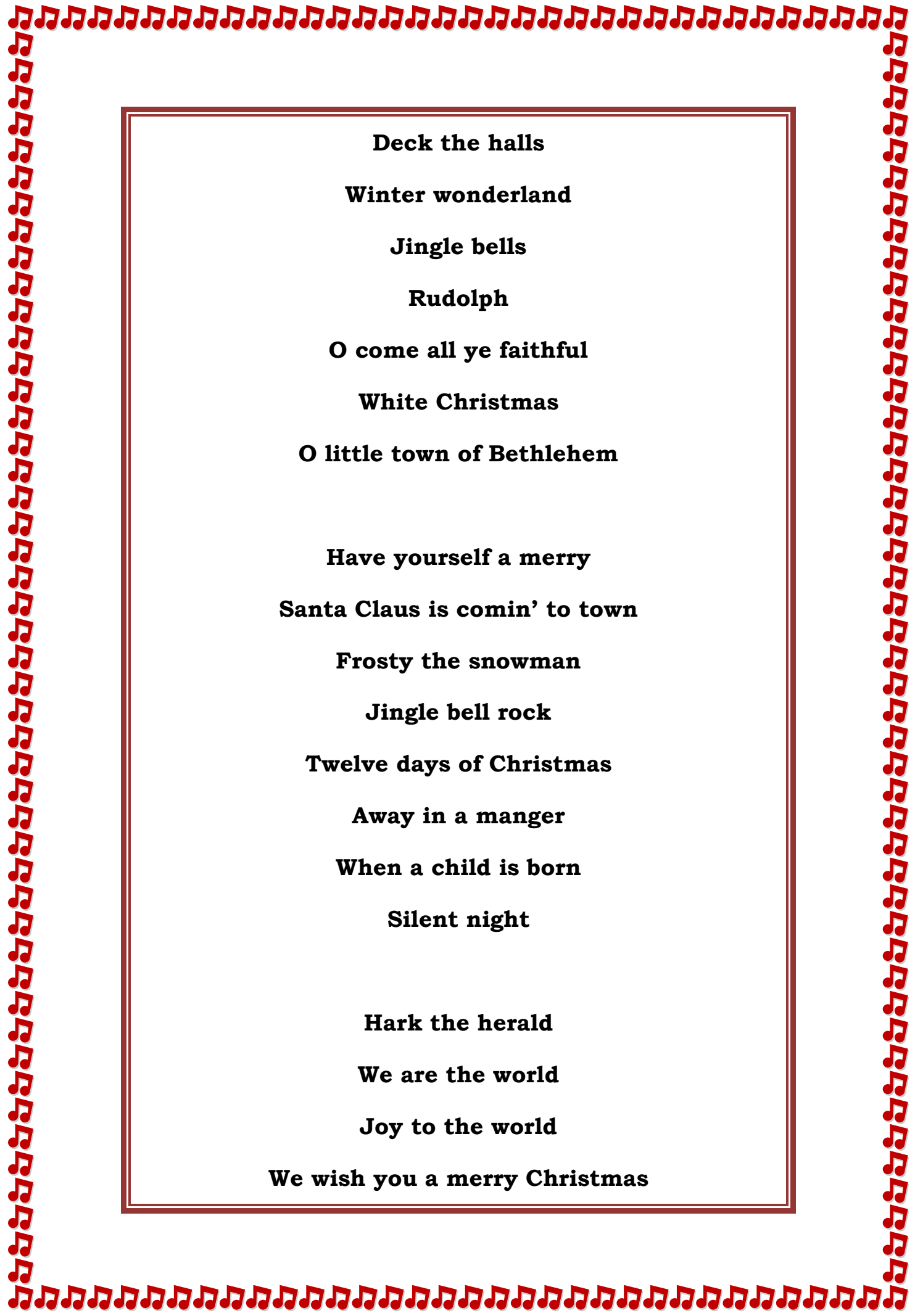

Until the other kids knock him down.*

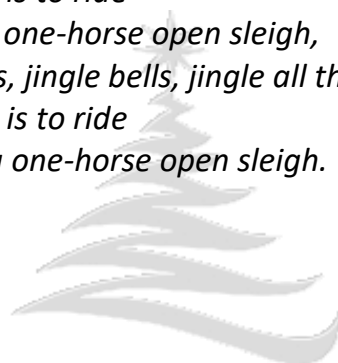
When it snows, ain't it thrilling,

This comes to pass when a child is born.

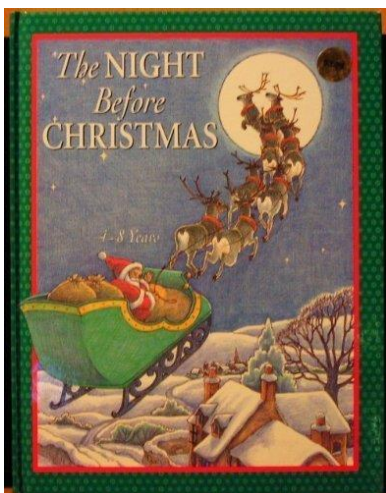
